



Data Wrangling Warriors: Official Rule Book

1. Introduction

Welcome to Data Wrangling Warriors! This competition challenges participants to demonstrate their skills in data cleaning, exploratory data analysis (EDA), data visualization, and storytelling within a timed environment. The event will take place over two days at the Expo Center, Karachi. Please review the following rules and guidelines to ensure a smooth and successful competition.

2. Event Details

- **Event Dates:** October 12-13, 2024
 - **Location:** Expo Center, Karachi
 - **Competition Duration:** 2 hours per team
 - **Schedule:**
 - **Data Cleaning, EDA, and Visualization:** 90 minutes
 - **Storytelling and Presentation:** 30 minutes

3. Objectives

Participants will be provided with a dataset and are required to:

1. **Data Cleaning:** Address and correct issues within the dataset.
 2. **Exploratory Data Analysis (EDA):** Analyze the dataset to uncover trends, patterns, and insights.
 3. **Data Visualization:** Create effective visual representations of the data.
 4. **Storytelling and Presentation:** Develop and present a compelling narrative based on the analysis.

4. Eligibility

1. **Participants:** Open to individuals or teams. Teams must consist of exactly 2 members.
 2. **Affiliations:** No restrictions based on professional or academic affiliations.

5. Dataset and Deliverables

1. Dataset Provision:

- **Format:** The dataset will be provided in CSV or Excel format at the start of the competition.
- **Access:** Datasets will be distributed on-site.

2. Deliverables:

- **Data Cleaning:** Cleaned dataset submitted within the 90-minute window.
 - **Exploratory Data Analysis (EDA):** EDA findings and insights to be shared in the same 90-minute window.
 - **Data Visualization:** Visualizations created during the 90-minute period.
 - **Storytelling and Presentation:** A 30-minute presentation summarizing the findings and insights.

6. Competition Format

1. Phase 1: Data Cleaning, EDA, and Visualization (90 minutes)

- **Tasks:** Clean the dataset, perform exploratory analysis, and create visualizations.
- **Tools:** Participants may use any software or tools they prefer.

2. Phase 2: Storytelling and Presentation (30 minutes)

- **Tasks:** Prepare and deliver a presentation that effectively communicates the analysis and insights.
 - **Format:** Presentations will be made to a panel of judges.

7. Judging Criteria

1. Data Cleaning:

- Accuracy in handling data issues.
- Completeness and consistency of the cleaned dataset.

2. Exploratory Data Analysis (EDA):

- Depth and relevance of the analysis.
- Insightfulness of findings.

3. Data Visualization:

- Clarity, effectiveness, and aesthetic quality of visualizations.
- Appropriateness of visualization methods.

4. Storytelling and Presentation:

- Coherence and persuasiveness of the narrative.
 - Quality and professionalism of the presentation.
 - Ability to clearly convey insights to a non-technical audience.

8. Code of Conduct

1. **Fair Play:** Participants must adhere to principles of honesty and integrity. Any form of cheating or plagiarism will result in disqualification.
2. **Respect:** Maintain respect for all participants, judges, and organizers.
3. **Collaboration:** Teams of exactly 2 members are allowed. All team members must contribute actively to the project.

9. Resources and Support

1. **Tools:** Participants may use any tools or software available to them.
2. **Guidelines:** Detailed competition guidelines will be provided on-site.
3. **Support:** On-site assistance will be available for any queries.

10. Prizes and Recognition

1. **Awards:** Prizes will be awarded to the top individuals or teams. Details on prizes will be announced separately.
2. **Recognition:** Winners will be featured on the event's website and may receive certificates or trophies.

11. Disqualification and Appeals

1. **Disqualification:** Grounds for disqualification include plagiarism, cheating, or failure to follow competition guidelines.
2. **Appeals:** Participants may appeal disqualification decisions by submitting a written request to the competition committee. The committee's decision is final.
